10-week Courses Starting January 2017 Suitable For Beginners

Drawing, Painting, Learning About Artists

Mondays 4.45 – 6.45pm

Start Date: Monday 16th January

Venue: Leeds Central Library, Calverley Street Leeds LS1 3AB

This course will introduce participants to the artwork of different artists, with the aim to develop skills in a range of media, including painting, drawing, collage, etc. Participants will learn about art from the 1960s onwards and will consider different genres in each session. Through learning about different artists and why they made the art they made, participants will be able to work in new ways and develop their own ideas using these methods.

Drawing And Painting At Inkwell

Tuesdays 1pm-3pm

Start date: Tuesday 10th January

Venue: Inkwell, 31 Potternewton Lane, LS7 3LW

Learn basic painting and drawing techniques. Use paper, canvas, pencil and paint to explore the theme of nature and the man made environment.

You will create a series of paintings and drawings and discuss artists who use similar themes as inspiration for their work.

Work mainly in the classroom and make gallery visits. There are regular one to one tutorials given as well as group critiques. These are informal, supportive and friendly. This course is aimed at people with some and no recent experience.

Jewellery Making At Feel Good Factor

Learn to create jewellery from old t-shirts, skirts and jeans. Learn how to use beading to bring new life to old clothes. Take away a selection of finished designs.

Sculpture at The Roscoe

Wednesdays 1pm – 3pm

Start Date: Wednesday 18th January

Venue: Roscoe Methodist Church, Francis Street, Leeds LS7 4BY

Participants will get ten weeks to work on a piece of 3D sculptural work. The themes will be personal and learners will be guided through various ways of developing an idea from inspiration to completion. Participants will be encouraged to use sketchbooks and research in the process. Materials available will include wire, tissue paper, modroc, clay, plaster and hessian. There will be support and guidance on casting, carving and building. Suitable for beginners and those with some previous knowledge.

Discovering Ceramics At Inkwell

Thursdays 2-4pm

Start date: Thursday 19th January

Venue: Inkwell, 31 Potternewton Lane, LS7 3LW

A course for beginners and those with some experience, you will make simple Slab pots, coil pots and have the opportunity to learn how to throw pots on the wheel. All materials are provided. Snacks, lunch and refreshments can be purchased from the Inkwell café.
